## Young Eagles Flight Rally

Area young people ages  
8-17 will have a chance  
to take to the skies on  
Saturday, September 10  
(rain date Sun.11th), as

Experimental Aircraft Association EAA Chapter  
602 hosts a Young Eagles Flight Rally at Fulton  
County Airport.

The rally is part of the EAA Young Eagles  
Program, created to interest young people in  
aviation. Since the program was launched in  
1992, Volunteer EAA pilots have flown more than  
1.4 million young people who reside in more than  
90 countries.

"Free airplane rides are just part of the Flight  
Rally," said Doug Sterling, spokesman for the  
event. "We hope to build one-to-one relationships  
between pilots and young people, giving a new  
generation a chance to learn more about the  
possibilities that exist in the world of aviation."

Pilots at the event will also explain more  
about their airplanes allowing young people  
to discover how airplanes work and how pilots  
ensure safety is the prime concern before every  
flight.

Following the flight, each young person, will  
receive a certificate making them  
an official Young Eagle. Their  
name will then be entered into the  
"World's Largest Logbook," which  
is on permanent display at the EAA  
Air Adventure Museum in Oshkosh,  
WI. The Logbook is also accessible  
on the web at [www.youngeagles.org](http://www.youngeagles.org).

Along with flight rallies, EAA  
members also fly Young Eagles  
on an individual basis. Each pilot  
volunteers their time and aircraft  
so the flights can be provided free of  
charge for interested young people.

Those attending the flight rally  
on September 10th are asked to  
come to Fulton County Airport,  
starting at 9am to register for their  
flight. Flights will begin at 9:30am,  
with registration closing at 2pm.

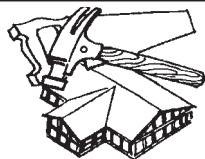

Cooperstown, N.Y. and the Lake Placid Lodge.

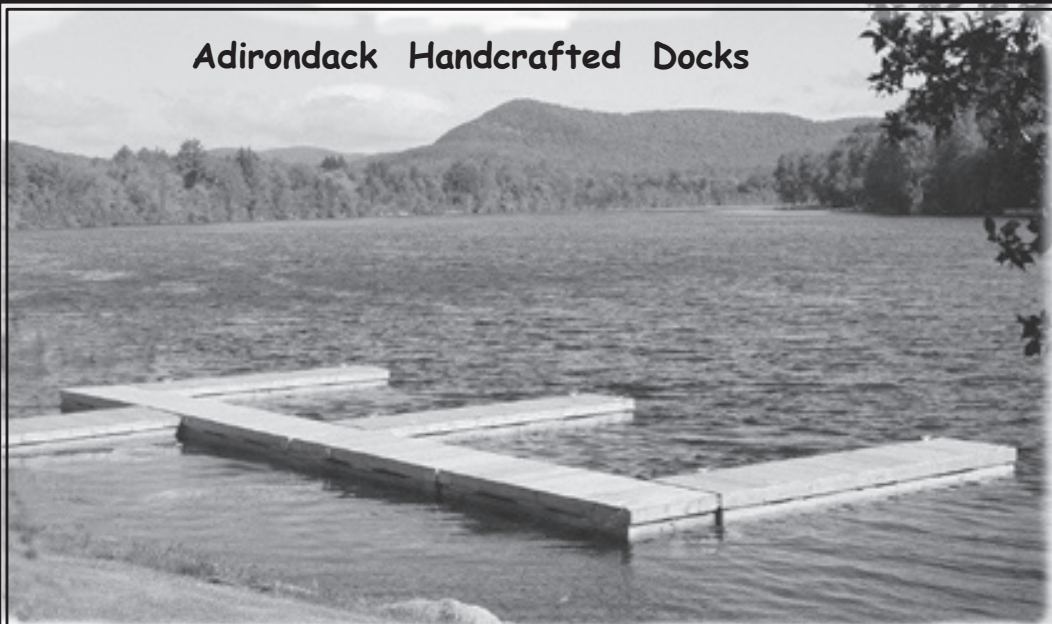

Steward Program's work in preventing the entry of invasive species into the lake. Chairman Hughes concluded by inviting applications from tax exempt or government entities for lake Settlement monies administered by the GSLAC. (More information is available from the GSLAC.)

Bob Jones from the Sacandaga Protection Committee (SPC) reviewed progress made by the SPC as well as the latest schedule for SPC fundraising in the lake community. The SPC announced a \$15,000 raffle to support the group's "...work in protecting the environmental, economic and legal interest of the entire Great Sacandaga Lake community." The newly-elected Sheriff of Fulton County, Richard Giardino, was thanked for listening to Association member concerns for the revival of the lake patrol. 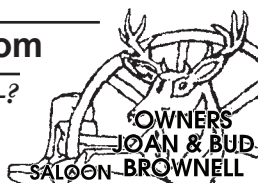

promised increased services to the lake community as additional resources became available.

Colonel Robert Smullen, USMC (ret) was welcomed to the meeting as was the Chairman of the Regulating District Board, Mark Finkle. Executive Director Smullen was introduced as a local resident who was returning home. Director Smullen shared his memories of the lake, his friendship with Sheriff Giardino and other members of the community. He recounted the results of his 'HRBRRD listening tour' since his appointment and noted that the latest review conducted by the Federal Energy Regulating Commission (FERC) of the Conklingville Dam gave the District positive marks. Director Smullen answered members' questions on the implementation of the Settlement agreement in our current drought conditions. Mr. Smullen extended an offer to meet at his office to provide specific answers to members about their particular Settlement implementation concerns.

**WATER QUALITY REPORT** – Last month we reported on the results of the first 2016 water

sampling conducted by the Darrin Fresh Water Institute from Lake George. The GSLA member funding has continued the GSLA Annual Water sampling program. GSLA funding allowed the Institute to develop a 'special' knowledge of our lake waters which spans many years. The water sampling provides an early warning if the water quality does not meet recreational standards. Our most recent results were once again, positive for the lake! That means both samplings were positive and we once again can announce that the lake is GREAT!

### Baked Pineapple

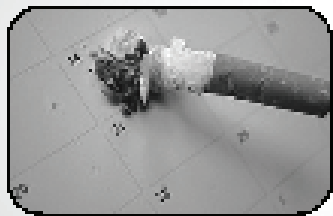
4 eggs lightly beaten with a whisk  
¾ cup white sugar  
1 stick of butter softened (you must use real butter!)  
1 cup of canned crushed pineapple (with the juice)  
5 slices of white bread (cubed, crusts too. I have even used hotdog rolls when I have no white bread on hand.

I figure one roll is equal to 1 slice of bread)

Stir everything together making sure the bread is completely covered with the egg/pineapple mixture. Pour mixture into a sprayed medium casserole dish. Bake at 350 degrees for 45 min. Serve hot. I usually triple this recipe for our family of 28 and make it in a 9 X 13 glass pan. (This is NOT a good recipe if you are counting your carbs and calories!)

Baked Pineapple is one of our family's favorites and besides making it for almost every picnic and church potluck, I also make it at Eastertime as it is a nice side dish with our ham dinner. I must share this story with you. While eating our Easter dinner one year our son-in-law Charlie said, "Hey Ma, I don't taste any pineapple in the Baked Pineapple?" 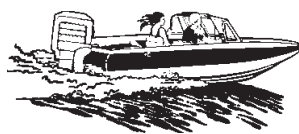

### FRUITS AND VEGGIES FOR YOUR HEALTH

Harvest time in Upstate NY is one of the best times of the year! From June strawberries to fall pumpkins, we enjoy an abundance of homegrown fruits and vegetables. Farmer's markets appear in Gloversville, Johnstown and Amsterdam, and little stands of fresh picked sweet corn and other veggies appear everywhere making getting a supply affordable.

You've heard it before – we are just not eating enough fruits and vegetables. U.S. Dietary Guidelines call for 3-5 servings of vegetables and 3-4 servings of fruit each day. But the fact is, less than 30% of us – that's 7 out of 10 Americans – are failing to meet these basic guidelines. Think about it...we are actually being asked to eat more of something. How often do you hear that?

Why not start a new habit during this time of abundance. It is easy to get all the nutrients

you need to feel good and look good if you just add fruits and veggies to every meal and snack. Here are some tips from the Hope Health Newsletter:

#### Breakfast

Top French toast or waffles with berries or slices of banana or kiwi fruit.  
Fill an omelet or scrambled eggs with mushrooms, onions, zucchini and/or spinach.  
Add fresh fruit to yogurt or cereal.

#### Lunch

Replace half the meat in a sandwich with extra slices of tomato and leafy lettuce.  
Add fruit slices or grapes to any green salad.  
Make peanut butter sandwiches with slices of apple or pear instead of jelly.  
Top a baked potato with broccoli or homemade salsa instead of butter or sour cream.  
Add your favorite chopped fruits or veggies to tuna or chicken salad.

#### Dinner

Garnish a filet of sole with grapes, or add fresh pineapple to grilled chicken.  
Finely chop any type of vegetable then sauté and add to lasagna.  
Stuff meatloaf with celery, onions, carrots and lentils.  
Spray fresh veggies lightly with olive oil and roast them in a 400 degree oven or grill them on skewers.  
Grill stone fruit like peaches, nectarines and plums for dessert.

I submitted my resignation and will be resigning as treasurer at the end of the year. I look forward to talking to you soon and I am looking forward to an extremely successful Redneck Event.

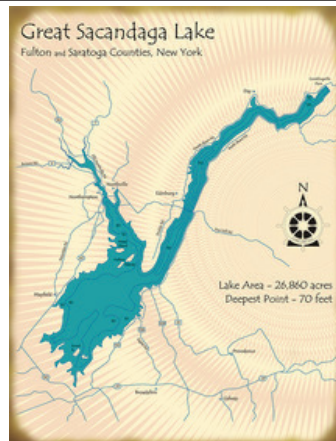

## Kripalu Center for Yoga & Health Awards Teaching for Diversity Grant to Transitions

Gloversville, NY – The Kripalu Center for Yoga & Health has awarded their Teaching for Diversity Grant to yoga instructor Ony Antonucci so she can deliver a weekly yoga series to students with learning differences at Transitions, co-located with the Paul Nigra Center for Creative Arts, at 2736 State Highway 30, Gloversville. The grant provided funding to cover supplies and 32 classes.

The Teaching for Diversity Grant is an initiative of the Kripalu Center, a nonprofit educational organization for yoga, health and holistic living, to share the benefits of yoga with diverse groups of students. The grants provide funding for graduates from the Kripalu Schools of Yoga and Ayurveda to get their programs started. Funding can be used to purchase supplies or to teach yoga or Ayurvedic practices to diverse populations, including students of Title I schools, ethnic minorities and individuals who are socially, economically and physically challenged.

Antonucci is a graduate of the Kripalu 500-hour advanced level yoga program. She has taught private and group lessons in Upstate New York for more than eight years. Transitions, a program that supports young adults who have autism and other learning differences as they attend college, start a career and live independently for the first time, is a perfect partner for her and the programming this grant funds. Antonucci recognizes the benefits of a yoga practice for all individuals, including those with special needs. When Transitions opened in 2015, they developed a program to offer yoga opportunities in the studio available to them at the Paul Nigra Center for Creative Arts. With the support of the Kripalu scholarship grant, this program will continue throughout 2016.

The students who attend Transitions learn breathing, movement and relaxation techniques that promote overall health, which is an important part of the Transitions curriculum. The yoga program has helped them in immeasurable ways by improving their focus and helping them manage the many responsibilities they face as busy young adults. College student and Transitions Apprentice Coty Rulison said, "Yoga helps take all the stress away from the demands of the classes and calms me so I can better focus on my homework and goals." Bethany Sweet, another Transitions Apprentice, agreed, saying, "The breathing techniques have really helped me destress and feel grounded in my busy life."

Upon the success of the Transitions yoga program, Antonucci suggested an application to the Teaching for

Diversity fund through Kripalu to expand the offerings to more individuals. The grant was awarded in April and the classes continue to be offered by Antonucci at Transitions. Antonucci hopes to encourage the students to practice yoga daily, and she would like to see them become yoga instructors and share the benefits of yoga with others who have challenges similar to theirs.

#### About Transitions

Transitions is a supportive Apprenticeship for young men and women with autism spectrum disorders including Asperger's syndrome, ADHD, dyslexia, nonverbal learning disabilities, visual or hearing impairments, medical conditions and other learning differences who want to attend college and/or prepare for a career, but may require academic, social, medical and/or emotional support.

The Transitions program's curriculum focuses on building academic, employment, life and general independence skills. Full-year College and Career Apprenticeship programs are offered, as well as a three-week Summer Immersion Experience. 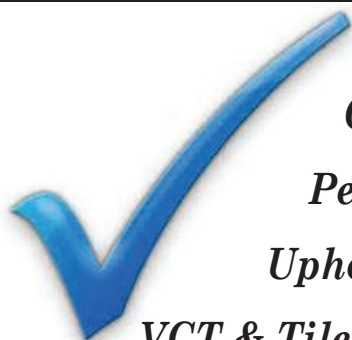

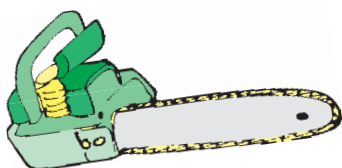

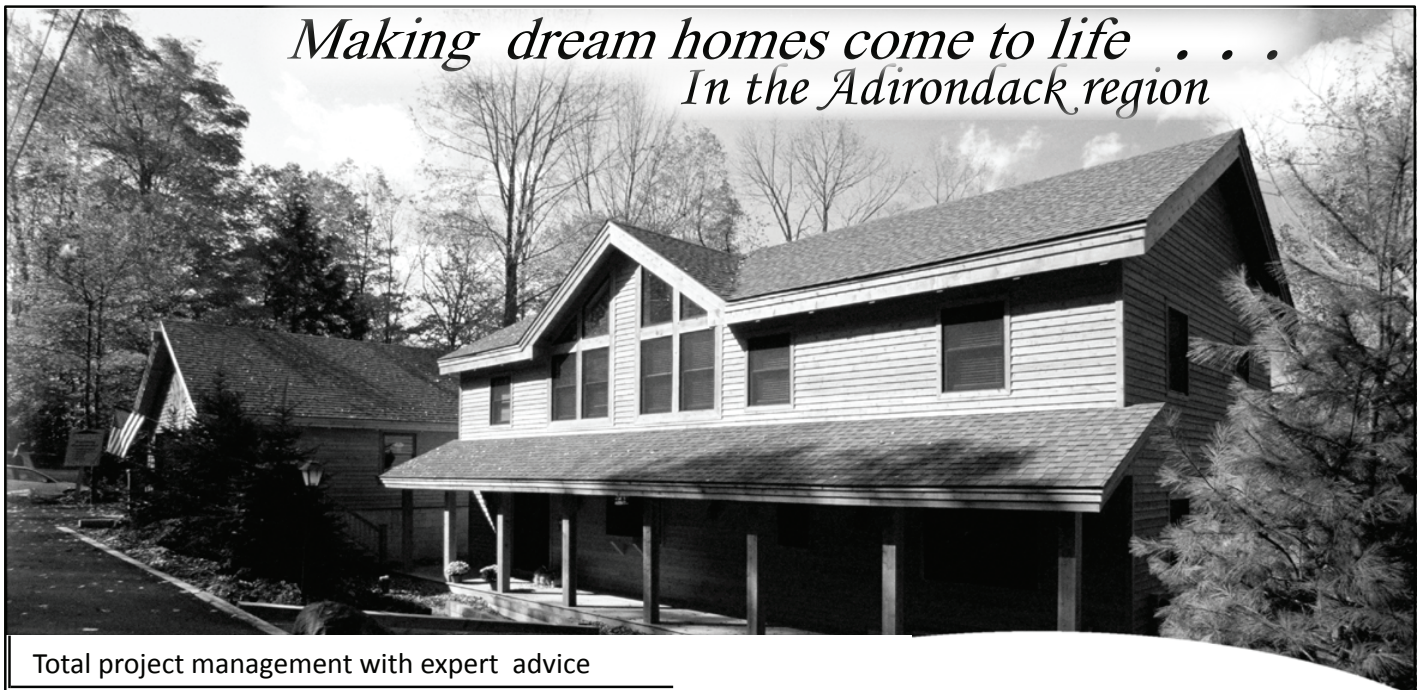
